Counter Affidavit filed today be kept on record.

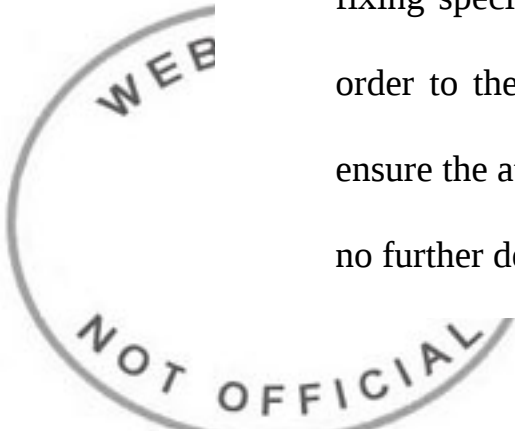
The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated
30.06.2014 by which the Special Judge, Vigilance, North Bihar,
