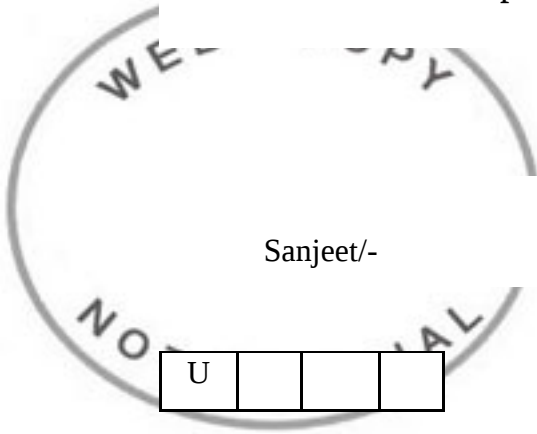
ORAL ORDER
