counsel for the State.

In this application filed under Articles 226 and 227 of
the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing of the first
information report in Paharpur P.S. Case No. 18 of 2014 registered
under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 353, 324, 307, 385, 386, 379 of
the Indian Penal Code, 27 of the Arms Act and 3(1)(x) of the S.C. &

S.T. (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and 3/5 of the Public Property Damage Act.

The allegations made in the FIR do constitute a cognizable offence.

In that view of the matter, I find no merit in this application. Accordingly, the application is dismissed.
