Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with

Saharsa S.C./S.T. P.S. Case No. 14 of 2014 registered for the

offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506/34 of the

Indian Penal Code and Section 3 (i) (x) (xi) of S.C./S.T.

(Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

Paragraphs no. 82 and 86 of the case diary reveal that
