ORAL ORDER

2 19-08-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 279, 427 of IPC ¾ of
Prevention of Damages to Public Property Act and Section 151 of
Railway Act.

Allegation is that the while driving a overloaded truck
beyond its height the petitioner entered into the bridge. Due to his
negligence and rash driving 35 pipes have been damaged when the
repair of railway project was going on.

It is submitted that the petitioner has not caused any
damage knowingly. He has been in custody since 9.5.2015 having
no criminal antecedent. However, after investigation charge-sheet

has already been submitted and there is no chance of tampering with the witnesses.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur, Ara/court concerned **after framing of charge** in Koilwar P. S. Case No. 101 of 2015 with following conditions:-

1. The petitioner will not indulge himself in similar or any other offence.
2. One of the bailors must be the close relative of the petitioner.
3. The petitioner will be well represented in the Court on each and every date and in case of absence for two consecutive dates or in case of violation of terms of bail, his bail bond would be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
