learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The name of petitioner surfaced in confessional statement of co-accused and thereafter, house of the petitioner was raided and it is alleged that one silver ring and mobile set were recovered.

According to the prosecution case, the aforesaid recovered articles are looted property of the present case but submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the aforesaid recovered articles have not been put on Test Identification Parade and moreover, the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and

circumstances of the case as well as submission of the parties, let the petitioner named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Lakhisarai P.S. Case No. 25 of 2015 to the satisfaction of Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai.
