ORAL ORDER

3 14-01-2015 Cr. Misc. No. 39765 of 2014 and Cr. Misc. No. 41675
of 2014 arise out of Sitamarhi P.S.Case No. 539 of 2014, as such,
both the applications have been heard together and are being
disposed of by this common order.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 448, 307, 353, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted that the allegation against the petitioner- Prem Kumar Yadav is to have abused and assaulted the informant (Sanjay Kumar Alok) with fist and slap and the allegation against petitioner- Gautam Kuamr is to have assaulted him with iron rod which caused injury in the hand.

It is submitted that the main allegation is against Manish Baitha, who is not the petitioner.

Both the petitioners are students studying in the college and petitioner- Prem Kumar Yadav is in custody since 06/07/2014 and petitioner- Gautam Kumar is in custody since 23/07/2014.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Sitamarhi in Sitamarhi P.S.Cse No. 539 of 2014 with the following conditions:

- (1) One of the bailors will be the close relative of the petitioner.
- (2) The petitioner will not indulge in similar or in any

other offence.

(3) The petitioner will be well represented in the court.

(4) In case of absence for two consecutive dates or in violation of the terms of the bail, his bail bond will be liable to be cancelled by the court concerned.
