Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and State.

The petitioner is a P.D.S. licensee, bearing License No. 20 of 2007. He prays for quashing the order as contained in Memo No. 892, dated 06.08.2014 passed by the Sub-Divisional Officer, Danapur, by which his P.D.S. license has been cancelled.

The petitioner filed an appeal/representation before the Collector, Patna.

In my view, the petitioner should file a proper appeal before the Collector, Patna against the order of cancellation. In case, such appeal is filed within a period of one month, the delay in filing the appeal would be condoned. It is further observed that the appellate authority would dispose of the appeal preferably

within a period of four months from the date of filing of the same.

This application stands disposed of.
