counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking bail in connection with Banka P.S. Case No. 460 of 2015 registered for offences under Sections 376 and 493 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the P.O.C.S.O. Act.

Allegation has been made against the petitioner to have abused the girl sexually.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of love affairs and now the present development is that both are ready to enter into a marriage and for that an application has been filed before the Sessions Court there it has been said that as the petitioner has refused to go for marriage, a criminal case has been

lodged.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Banka in connection with Banka P.S. Case No. 460 of 2015.
