ORAL ORDER

2 14-10-2015 The petitioner apprehends his arrest in relation to Bettiah

Muffasil (Manuapul) P.S. Case No. 310 of 2011, instituted under

sections 467, 468, 471, 406, 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner points out that co-
accused Anil Sah has already been granted anticipatory bail. This
is also noticed by the learned Sessions Judge, but in spite of that,
and in spite of the fact that the allegation is of mere breach of
contract, which is purely a civil dispute, the learned Sessions
Judge has refused to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Having perused the order of the learned Sessions Judge,
this Court is, indeed, surprised at the manner in which the learned
Sessions Judge has proceeded in the matter.

Be that as it may, in the event of arrest or surrender in the court below within four weeks, the above named petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran, in connection with Bettiah Muffasil(Manuapul) P.S. Case No. 310 of 2011, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
