Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the
State.

The Petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case
instituted for the offence under Section(s) 302, 201/34 Indian
Penal Code.

Considering that the Petitioner is the mother-in-law
of the deceased and it is not a case under Section 304-B Indian
Penal Code which would raise presumption against the in-laws,
it is ordered that in the event of surrender/arrest of the Petitioner,
named above, within four weeks from the date of
receipt/production of a copy of this order in connection with
Andar P.S. Case No.151 of 2014, she shall be released on
anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹5,000/- (five
thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each or any other

surety to be fixed by the court below to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Siwan, subject to the conditions as laid down under sections 438(2) Cr. P. C. and (i) That one of the bailors will be a close relative of the Petitioner, who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the Petitioner. The bailors will undertake to furnish information to the court about any change in the address of the Petitioner, (ii) That the Petitioner will give an undertaking that she will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if she fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, her bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse, and (iii) That the Petitioner will be well represented on each date and if she fails to do so on two consecutive dates, her bail will be liable to be cancelled.
