The grievance of the petitioner is that the concerned
authorities have not calculated the statutory interest in the light of
judgment passed in Bijay L. Mehrotra Vs The State of UP
reported in AIR 2000 SC 3513(2) but in my view, the aforesaid
judgment is not applicable in the present matter because the
concerned officials disposed off the representation of the
petitioner, taking into consideration his grievance and the

concerned authorities directed to make payment of dues of the petitioner in accordance with law.

Hence I do not find any merit in this petition.

Accordingly, this contempt petition stands disposed off.
