Heard the parties.

The petitioner is aggrieved by the order/ notification dated 27.10.2014 (Annexure-1) issued under the signature of respondent no.5, whereby he has been transferred from Patna and has been posted at District Prosecution Office, Muzaffarpur on the post of Assistant Prosecution Officer.
