In view of report of the Juvenile Justice Board, East Champaran, Motihari, that the enquiry is likely to be concluded within 180 working days, I am not inclined to interfere with the order dated 03.09.2014 passed by the 4th Additional Sessions Judge, East Champaran, Motihari, in Cr. Appeal No.77 of 2014/ 108 of 2014 affirming the order dated 02.07.2014 passed by the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, East Champaran at Motihari, in JJB Trial No.801 of 2014 arising out of Pakaridayal P.S. Case No.59 of 2014.

The Revision Application is **dismissed**.
