ORAL ORDER

2 23-04-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in
connection with Excise Case No. 55 of 2014 instituted under
Sections 47A of the Bihar Excise Act, 1915.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits
that though there is allegation of recovery of 19200 sachets of
country made liquor totaling 3840 litres but according to her,
the petitioner being the owner of the pick-up van had no
concern with the consignment.

Learned A.P.P. submits that such a huge
quantity of country made liquor had been loaded on the pick-
up van of the petitioner and him having no knowledge of the
same cannot be believed.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail.

The application, accordingly, stands dismissed.

However, in the event the petitioner surrenders and prays for regular bail before the Court below, the same shall be considered on its own merits without being prejudiced by the present order of rejection.
