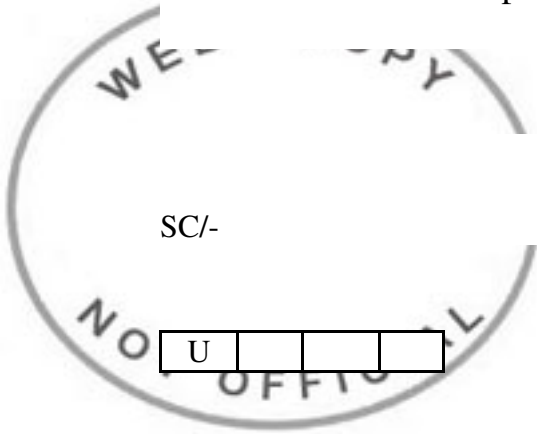

In view of the stand taken in paragraph 10 of the counter affidavit and the order dated 16.09.2015 passed by the District Magistrate-cum-Licensing Authority granting further three months' time to the petitioner for purchase of a new revolver/pistol, learned counsel for the petitioner clearly admits that this application has become infructuous and as such, she would not be prosecuting this application.
