The petitioner has prayed for a writ of Habeas
Corpus alleging that her detention in After Care Home, Nazarath
Mokama, District Patna is illegal.

Although it is not specifically stated but it
appears from the averments made in the writ petition that the
detention of the petitioner in the said After Care Home is pursuant
to a judicial order.

In the aforesaid circumstance, it cannot be said
that the detention of the petitioner is illegal. No writ of Habeas

Corpus can, accordingly, be issued.

This writ application is dismissed. If the petitioner is aggrieved by the Judicial order, she has liberty to take recourse to appropriate proceedings before an appropriate forum.
