Heard both sides.

The petitioner Sanjay Bhagat seeks regular bail in Motipur P.S. Case No. 07 of 2013, registered for the offences punishable under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is not named in the First Information Report. Name of the petitioner figured in the case in the confessional statement of Vijay Sahni. Except the confessional statement, the petitioner was not put on Test Identification Parade. Investigating Officer did not collect any other tangible evidence.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the fact that petitioner is in jail since 28.05.2014, he is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten

Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M. (West) Muzaffarpur in connection with Motipur P.S. Case No. 07 of 2013.
