2 08-04-2015 Heard both sides.

The petitioner seeks bail in Akbarpur P.S. Case No. 187 of 2014, corresponding to Sessions Trial No. 13/15/2/15, registered for the offences punishable under Section 307 and other Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is alleged to have assaulted Sandip Kumar son of the informant with Khanti on his head.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that Sandip Kumar got one injury on his head measuring 1½”x1½”x1½”, but the nature of injury was kept reserved. The police submitted charge sheet without obtaining the opinion of the nature of the injury. The petitioner is the co-sharer and neighbour of the informant. The occurrence took place due to land dispute and the

petitioner has already remained in jail for more than seven months.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above named is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Ad hoc Additional Sessions Judge-II, Nawada in connection with Akbarpur P.S. Case No. 187 of 2014, corresponding to Sessions Trial No. 13/15/2/15.
