4 03-02-2015 Despite repeated calls, none appears on behalf of the petitioner in support of the present writ petition, though the name of learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner is printed in the daily cause list.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that an identical matter came up for consideration before another Bench, of course at the behest of another petitioner, but that writ petition was dismissed. The matter was taken to LPA Court and ultimately the LPA was also dismissed. However, the orders passed in the connected matters have not been brought on record.
