2 01-05-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 353 and 506 of the
Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged by the CDPO that during inspection of the
Anganbari Centre, the petitioner being husband of the Sevika did
not allow to produce register and other documents and threatened
the informant.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner
that only on suspicion the accusation has been levelled. Statement
has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has
no criminal antecedent.

Considering the nature of accusation, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Kaimur at Bhabua in connection with Bhagwanpur P.S. Case No. 160 of 2014 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
