The parties shall be at liberty to raise all the issues of facts and law before the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna,

If an appropriate petition is filed on behalf of the petitioners before the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna within a period of two months from today with a certified copy of the present order and if it is found that it has become barred by limitation and if any petition is filed on behalf of the petitioners for condonation of such delay, then the learned Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna shall take into consideration that on a bona fide legal advice, the present writ petition was filed before this Court on 27.08.2012 and that remained pending till date.
