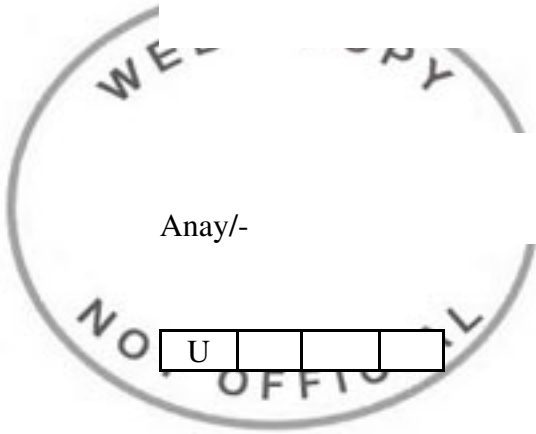
Heard the parties.
