The name of petitioner came in this case in
confessional statements of co-accused, Chandra Mohan and
Sachet Yadav and looted flour was recovered from the house of
co-accused, Bachhu Mahto. So far as petitioner is concerned,
nothing has been recovered from his conscious possession nor has
he been put on Test Identification Parade.
