Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 379, 411 and 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 40 of the Mines & Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957.

Two tractors loaded with sand were intercepted when the driver suggested that after making payment to agent of the petitioner the sand being transported.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that there is nothing on record to suggest that any payment was made to the petitioner or the petitioner's agent when the contract of the alleged sand was given to Aditya Multicom Pvt. Ltd.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or

surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with Amba P.S. Case No.36 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
