Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the

State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Section 376/511 of
the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case is that this petitioner made an
attempt to ravish the seven years old daughter of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the accusation is neither being supported by the
independent witness nor by the medical opinion.

The aforesaid facts constitute ground for
consideration of prayer for regular bail. Let the learned Court
below consider the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner, if the

petitioner surrenders within a period of six weeks in connection with Kesaria P.S. Case No.182 of 2014, pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Sadar, East Champaran at Motihari.
