The leeway which the petitioner is looking for in matter of transfer cannot be extended to him for the reason that the petitioner has already spent about four years in the present place of posting. Standards of discipline and enforcement of rules are of much higher order in relation to persons working in Para Military Force. The Court cannot exercise its discretion in such matters by intervening when no illegality as such in the decision relating to transfer of the petitioner is made out.

Writ application is dismissed.

If the petitioner exhausts remedy provided internally, the Court will not come in the way.
