Having regard to the facts, which have been stated

in the present writ petition, we are of the view that a proper and

effective investigation is needed in the present case.

In view of the above and in the interest of justice, we close this writ petition with direction to the Officer-in-Charge, Bettiah Muffasil Police Station, to investigate in accordance with law Bettiah Muffasil Police Station Case No.377 of 2015 and bring the same to its logical conclusion expeditiously.

We also direct the Superintendent of Police, West Champaran At Bettiah, to ensure that the investigation in the case aforementioned is carried out in accordance with law and effectively so that the investigation is brought to its logical conclusion.

During the course of investigation, if the alleged victim is recovered, learned Magistrate concerned shall pass such order/ orders as may be deemed necessary and appropriate.
