learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest for the

offences alleged under Sections 498(A) of the Indian Penal

Code registered in connection with Complaint Case No.

160 of 2015.

3. It is submitted that the petitioners being the

parents-in-law of the complainant have been falsely

implicated as the thrust of accusation is against the

husband of the complainant. The petitioners claim clean

antecedents and this is the first complaint of its nature

implicating them when the complainant has married as far

back as in the year 2007.

4. Having regard to the entirety of the facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of the petitioners arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Rajesh Kumar, learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nawada, in connection with Complaint Case No. 160 of 2015 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
