Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case under
Section 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and under section 27 of
the Arms Act.

The petitioner is named in the FIR but only suspicion
is raised against the petitioner that petitioner and others had
threatened to kill the wife of informant only because wife of the
informant has practiced witchcraft on the family members of the
petitioner.

It is submitted that there is no material except
suspicion. Similarly situated accused Ravi Shankar Kumar @ Ravi
and Chandrabali Mistry have already been granted anticipatory
bail. Ashok Mistry has been granted regular bail.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the nature of allegations made against the petitioner, the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in Gaya Muffasil P.S. Case No. 214 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
