2 02-12-2015 These are the applications, made under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail by the petitioners, namely, Surendra Baitha, Ram Kripal Sahni, Sunil Sahni, Bhupendra Sahni @ Bhulendra Sahni and Ranjeet Sahni, in connection with Hathauri Police Station Case No. 101 of 2015, under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code, Sections 25(1-b)A/26/35 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Section 3 of the Explosive Substances Act.

Perused the above applications and materials on record.

Heard Mr. Hari Kishore Thakur and Mr. S. Jamil Akhtar, learned Counsel, appearing on behalf of the petitioners, and Mr. Ajay Kumar No.2, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of State.
