Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 188 of 2015 registered under Sections 414 of the Indian Penal Code and 25(1-B)(a), 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

It is contended that the petitioner has been roped in a false case. There is no independent witness to corroborate the allegation made in the FIR. The seizure list witnesses have not supported the allegation made in the FIR in course of investigation.

Regard being had to the recovery of one country-made loaded pistol from possession of the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant him bail. Accordingly, the prayer for bail is rejected.

In case the trial is not concluded within six months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of the order, the petitioner would be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
