ORAL ORDER

2 15-12-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341/447/323/337/307/504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that all the accused persons variously armed with entered into the house of the informant when co-accused Laddulal Tanti made assault on the head of the son of the informant with iron rod, as a result son of the informant became unconscious and, thereafter, co-accused Ranbir Tanti and Maltan Tanti assaulted on his head with 'lathi' when informant came to rescue then petitioner no.3 Subhash Tanti and petitioner no.4 Pokhan Tanti assaulted the informant with 'lathi' caused injury on

his leg and thigh. It is further alleged that when informant's wife Suma Devi came to rescue the she was also assaulted by the accused persons.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that accusation of assault is not against petitioner nos. 1 and 2 whereas injury of the informant and his son has been found to be simple in nature. There is counter version of the occurrence wherein petitioners' sides have also received injuries. Moreover, a statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Khagaria in connection with Khagaria Muffasil P.S. Case No.676/2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
