ORAL ORDER

3 05-01-2015 Petitioner is languishing in custody since
10.04.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 364(A), 379 of the I.P.C.

The prosecution case is of kidnapping the
informant and his two sons. Subsequently the informant and
his one son were released but another son Santosh Singh was
not released and ransom was demanded. One co-accused Paras
Yadav was apprehended on the spot who disclosed the name of
this petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the prosecution agency never got any process
issued against this petitioner and the petitioner has been
remanded in the present case from Thakraha P.S. Case No. 154
of 2012 when no T.I.P of the petitioner has been held. It is
further submitted that apprehended accused Paras Yadav has

already been granted bail.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner is accused in one other case apart from the present one.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bagaha, West Champaran in connection with Semra P.S. Case No. 21 of 2002.

Since the case was registered in 2002 and petitioner was named in the F.I.R and he was remanded in the present case on 10.04.2014, learned Court below will positively cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner, if the petitioner defaults for three consecutive occasions during the trial.
