Petitioner has superannuated. He was awarded punishment of 'censure', which relates to the year 2006-2007.

2. Other punishment is withholding of one increment without cumulative effect.

3. Both the punishments after superannuation have lost their meaning. If the petitioner had remained in service, may be it would have created some adverse situation when the question of promotion would have been taken, but that is not the position as of now.

4. Writ application is dismissed on that score. Any

adjudication will be academic now.
