3 03-08-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

Case diary has been received, which is taken on record.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Nawada Town (Kadirganj) P.S. Case No. 182 of 2014 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 307, 448, 436, 427, 504 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegation levelled in the prosecution version is general and omnibus and the same has not been supported by the informant in his re-statement

Considering the nature of allegation and also the fact

that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Nawada in connection with Nawada Town (Kadirganj) P.S. Case No. 182 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
