ORAL ORDER

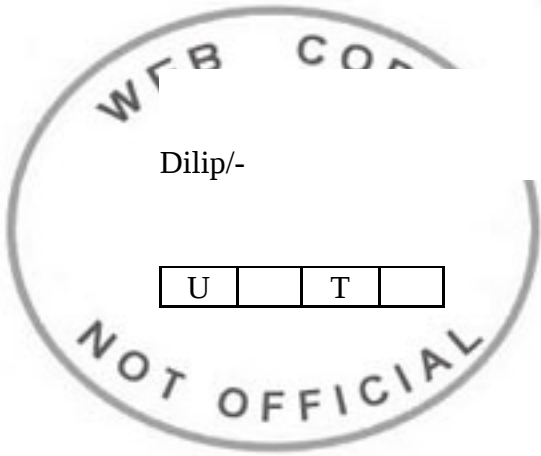
3 30-01-2015 Heard both sides.

Case No. 69 of 2014 registered under Sections 25(1-b)a/35 of the
Arms Act.

It appears that from the possession of the petitioners,
one country-made pistol was recovered. The petitioners are
brothers. The petitioners are in jail since 13.06.2014.

Considering that only country-made pistol without
