3 03-03-2015 This is an application, made under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail for the accused-petitioners, namely, Deepak Kumar and Vikash Kumar, in connection with Akilpur Police Station Case No. 19 of 2014, under Sections 342/376/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Protection of Children Sex Offences Act, 2012.
