ORAL JUDGMENT

The Petitioner seeks revision of the judgment dated 18.7.2014, by which the Principal Judge, Family Court, Muzaffarpur has fixed maintenance of Rs.10,000/- per month to the Opposite Party No.2 in Maintenance case No.110 of 2013.

The Petitioner has filed his salary slip, according to which, he receives around Rs.2,68,540/- per year, which means that he earns Rs.23,000/- per month.

The Counsel for the Opposite Party No.2 submits that in fact the Petitioner earns about Rs.36,000/- per month, which the Petitioner explains, is reimbursable as travelling expenses.

Be that as it may, considering the facts of the case, the

amount of Rs.10,000/- is reduced to Rs.8000/- per month. The Court below is directed to ensure compliance of its order if the Petitioner does not deposit the amount of arrears within reasonable time.

Application stands allowed.
