The petitioner is residing in a rental premises bearing MIG Flat No. 6/8-261 from which the electric connections were disconnected on account of non-payment of energy bill. It appears from the instructions received that a new electric connection has been given in favour of Sunil Kumar Singh, the owner of the premises.

In this view of the matter, I find that the dispute with respect to grant of electric connection has been redressed vide letter no. 657 dated 23.05.2015 issued by the Electrical Energy, Bahadurpur.

Writ application is, accordingly, disposed of.
