This Court cannot show more sympathy and
grant more indulgence over and above what the Tribunal
has already done in O.A. 868 of 2012 in its order dated
13th of September, 2013, contained in Annexure-5.

In fact the Court wonders as to why the
petitioner has filed a writ application, assailing the order
of the Tribunal, because the maximum which could be

done has already been done and nothing further is required to be added by way of indulgence to the petitioner.

Let the petitioner go and join the transferred place of posting. Once he joins, respondents will be free to take into consideration the observation of the Tribunal and decide the fate of the petitioner.

Writ application is disposed off with observation as above.
