Heard learned counsel for the parties.

It is evident from reading of Annexure-1 that no financial commitment was made to the institution of the petitioner while permitting them to upgrade the teaching of the Madarsa to Fouquania and may be Moulvi.

Since the allocation of financial kind or recognition is a matter of policy, the Court can only permit the petitioner to approach the State authorities with a demand. They have an obligation upon them to

consider and pass an appropriate order preferably within a period of three months. The Court does not express any opinion on the merit of the claim of the petitioner.

Writ application stands disposed off with observation as above.
