ORAL JUDGMENT

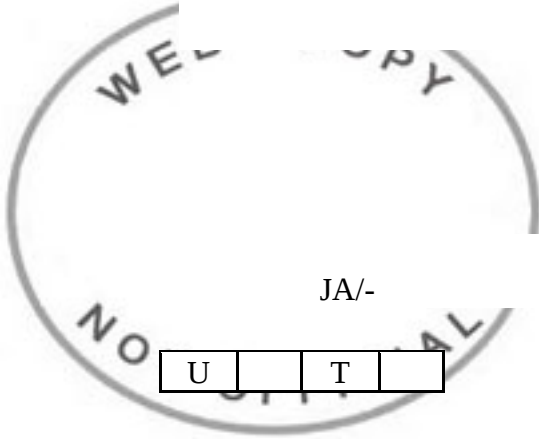

Considering that there is every likelihood that the Petitioner will intermingled with the antisocial elements which is his past record as reveals, I am not inclined to interfere in the judgment and order dated 31st January, 2015, passed by the Sessions Judge, Begusarai, in Cr. Appeal No.15 of 2015, affirming the order dated 08.01.2015 passed by the Juvenile Justice Board, Begusarai, in Matihani P.S. Case No.89 of 2014.

The application stands dismissed.

The Juvenile Justice Board is directed to conclude the enquiry expeditiously for which reason it shall send a list of the witnesses fixing specific dates for their examination along with a copy of this order to the concerned Superintendent of Police, who is
