Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor.

Informant, after withdrawing the amount from UCO
Bank was in a way to his house along with his son over
motorcycle was robbed of. Because of the fact that some delay has
been caused at the end of the bank officials to make payment
therefore, informant had named those officials alone.

So far petitioner is concerned, from the order
impugned it is evident that save and except inculpatory extra
judicial confessional statement of the petitioner coupled with
criminal antecedent nothing more has been collected. Moreover,
there happens to be specific disclosure at the end of the petitioner
that he had not been put on T.I. Parade.

Accordingly, petitioner *Loha Yadav @ Abhay Singh*

is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned *Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar* in connection with *Nawanagar P.S. Case No.45 of 2014*, subject to condition that petitioner will give an undertaking that whenever and wherever police will requisition him for conduction of T.I. Parade, he will be available. Having violation of the undertaking at the end of the petitioner will automatically cease the operation of the instant order.
