4 29-09-2015 Supplementary affidavit is filed on behalf of the
petitioner.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State and learned counsel,
appearing for the informant.

The victim has stated in her statement recorded u/S
164 of the Cr. P.C. that this petitioner kidnapped her and also
committed rape as a result thereof, she became pregnant. The
victim was medically examined and her pregnancy was found
positive. The victim was also found minor.

Therefore, considering the above-said submission as
well as facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to
release the petitioner on bail and hence, his prayer for bail in

connection with Bathnaha P.S. Case No. 194 of 2014 corresponding to Sessions Trial No. 259 of 2015 pending in the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, Sitamarhi stands rejected.

However, learned trial court is directed to expedite the trial of the petitioner and try to conclude the same as early as possible.

This court hopes and expects that the informant shall produce his witnesses before the trial court as early as possible.
