ORAL ORDER

The present application has been filed for
modification of order dated 23.11.2011 passed in Cr. Misc. No.
38794 of 2011 for confirmation/extension of the period of
provisional anticipatory bail.

The petitioner being the husband of the
complainant was granted provisional anticipatory bail in
connection with Complainant Case No. 496(C) of 2011 wherein
processes were directed to be issued after cognizance being taken
for the offences punishable under Section 498A of the Indian
Penal Code pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist
Class, Patna.

The provisional anticipatory bail was
granted to the petitioner on readiness of the petitioner to

keep the complainant as wife with dignity and honour and the petitioner has not performed second marriage. The provisional bail was to be confirmed by the learned court below within a period one year if the matrimonial harmony is substantially restored or if the complainant deliberately refuses to reside with the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the issue has been settled between the parties outside the court.

Considering the fact that the period of provisional anticipatory bail expired on 22.11.2012 and the present modification application has been filed on 07.05.2014, this Court is not inclined to entertain the present modification application.

However, this order will not preclude the learned court below to consider the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

Accordingly, this modification application is disposed of.
