2 16-02-2015 Having regard to the fact that the petitioner claims to

be the second wife of the deceased employee, namely, Achhelal
Thakur and is before this Court with a prayer for grant of family
pension, the issue, having already been decided by this Court in an
identical case in the case of ***Kalawati Devi vs. the State of Bihar***
& Ors. reported in ***2014(3)PLJR 587***, has to be essentially
rejected because this Court in the case of ***Kalawati Devi*** (supra)
has gone to hold that the second wife cannot claim any family
pension.

That being so, this writ application is dismissed.
