counsel representing the State.

The petitioners, apprehending their arrest in connection
with Mehus P.S. Case No. 24 of 2013 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 302 and 201/34 of the Indian Penal
Code, seek the privilege of pre-arrest bail.

At the very outset, it has been submitted that in this case,
the police after completing investigation, submitted charge sheet
