The girl Babita Kumari expressed her desire that she wanted to go with her husband Kisan Kumar which is stated to be alias name of the petitioner, Krishna Yadav.

In the aforesaid circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.

The writ application is, accordingly, dismissed as infructuous.
