Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
counsel for the Vigilance, Mr. Arvind Kumar.

The petitioner assails the order dated 18.07.2012 passed
in Complaint Case No. 14 of 2006 by the learned Special Judge,
Vigilance, North Bihar, Muzaffapur whereby the complaint case filed
by the complainant has been dismissed.

From the perusal of the order dated 18.07.2012, it
appears that the Complaint Case No. 14 of 2006 was filed by the
petitioner alleging gross illegality, irregularity and corruption by
public servants in his village Pirapur, Block-Bandra, District-
Muzaffarpur of the various works done by those public servants. The

petitioner had applied for information regarding such acts to the Panchayat Secretary-cum-Public Information Officer and the same has been provided after appeal has been filed.

No ground has been made out for interfering with the order dated 18.07.2012 passed in Complaint Case No. 14 of 2006 by the Special Judge, Vigilance, North Bihar, Muzaffarpur, this application is dismissed.
